The Diocesan celebration to mark the Canonisation of Cardinal Newman: This will take the form of Choral Ecumenical Vespers with Archbishop Bernard and other Anglican Bishops and Church leaders. In this way, it marks Newman as a priest of the city of Birmingham, but also as a Saint of our Archdiocese. It is an ecumenical occasion recognising Newman's journey of faith. The joint choirs of St Chad's Cathedral and St. Philip's Cathedral will lead the singing. Vespers at 4pm on Sunday 20th October.

The Saturday Lunches have resumed on Saturday 14th September 2019. Please do support.

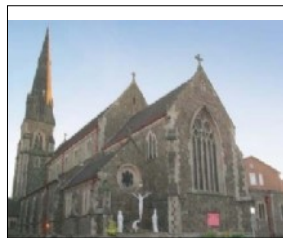
The Church Choir: We are in need of parishioners who can play keyboard to support the music in church. There is great joy in making music for the Lord; please come and have this joy with the Lord.

John Henry Newman

This weekend, this very day in fact, in Rome the Pope is canonising John Henry Newman as a saint of the Roman Catholic Church. We can take especial pleasure in this because for most of his life he lived in this diocese, both in Oxford as an Anglican and at the Oratory in Birmingham as a Catholic. He even came to this church on one occasion (1846) for the consecration of William Ullathorne as bishop of the West Country (it was he who built this church). He is very much our saint and will surely intercede for us when we ask him in our prayers.

John Henry was born in London in 1801, went to Trinity College in Oxford in 1817 and being a great scholar was made a fellow of Oriel College. He became a renowned preacher at St Mary's in Oxford, many undergraduates flocked to hear him. In 1833 he became one of the leaders of a movement to make the Anglican Church more Catholic in outlook and ceremony. In this he succeeded up to a point and is honoured for this among Anglicans but finally decided he had to join the Church of Rome which he did in 1845.

As a Catholic he founded the Oratory in Birmingham and lived there until his death in 1890. Through his many writings he did much to make Roman Catholics more accepted and respected in this country especially when he was made a Cardinal. Up to 20,000 people lined the streets of Birmingham to see his funeral cortege go by. He was a great intellectual and also a very caring pastor but above all a great saint who is being upheld today as an example for us all to follow.
