HE IS RISEN ALLELUIA!

Easter is one of the greatest feasts of the Christian faith. The defeat of evil and death, achieved by the resurrection of Jesus Christ, is the basis of our faith and our belief in God. May this Easter bring us renewed hope to approach life issues with sincere trust and faith in the Lord, who has defeated evil and death by his resurrection from the dead.
