'THEY RECOGNISED THE LORD AT THE BREAKING OF BREAD.'

The strength and commitment of Christian life is drawn from the regular and devoted reception of the Sacrament of Penance and of the Eucharist. The irregular reception and inappropriate reverence we may sometimes show to these sacraments can dry up our spiritual strength and weaken our willingness to do good. When this happens we may become susceptible to sin and show little interest in the Lord and also have a lack of concern for others. As mentioned, in the early Church, what united the first disciples was the breaking of bread, and they would recognise the presence of Lord among them and in each other, though he would immediately vanish from their sight. That in fact, was to emphasise his spiritual presence with them, although he was not always physically visible. Our Christian communities, families and parishes should therefore, renew their commitment to listen to the Word of God received through the Holy Scriptures. We should also receive the Sacraments regularly in order to be able to fight the evils of envy, greedy, pride, resentment, selfishness, uncontrolled emotional desires and disorders in moral behaviours. May we therefore, recognise the Lord's presence in the celebration of the Eucharist and show our true love for each other as partakers of one bread and one cup from the same altar of the Lord.

As we celebrate the 3rd Sunday of Easter, the readings draw our attention to the need to renew our faith in the Sacrament of the Eucharist and in the Holy Scriptures. In today's gospel, the Risen Lord appeared to the disciples and they were overloved, although some at first thought they were seeing a ghost. They recognised him when he asked for breakfast. A meal which was again taken together, pointing to the sacrament of the Eucharist. While at the breakfast, he told them. "This is what I meant when I said, while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Law of Moses, in the Prophets and in the Psalms, has to be fulfilled. Then their eyes were opened' (Lk24:44-45). Just as in our Liturgy today, we need to follow and listen the Word of God so that we can receive Holy Com-

munion worthily. The liturgy of the Word prepares us to receive the Lord in Holy Communion. As Saint John said, 'Loving and knowing God, is by following his commandments' (1Jn2:3-4), which we hear every time we read the Scriptures. May we then renew and reform our ways, hearing God's word and receiving him in the Holy Eucharist showing true love for him and for our fellow human beings.
