

### **'RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT'**

The Apostles were encouraged by the gracious words of Jesus when he said, 'And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you' (Jn14:16). During our journey of life, we need some assurance and support from members of our family or from members of the community to which we belong. The foundation of the Church would have been very difficult for the disciples if it were not for the power of the Holy Spirit, as promised to them by our Lord Jesus Christ. On the day of Pentecost, fifty days after the resurrection of the Lord, they received supernatural power to face the challenges of the day and to proclaim the Gospel of Christ boldly. At first, despite his occasional appearances, the disciples were still in great fear and others like Thomas doubted. It wasn't until Pentecost day, when they were spiritually energized that they retrogressively understood what the Lord had told them. It is also relevant to us, in modern times, to internalize the living presence of the Holy Spirit in our sacramental commitment. This will enable us to understand ourselves and the world we live in. We should be aware of the evil of the modern persecution of our faith in God, such as religious indifferences, digital distractions, busy lives and scientific skepticism. Unless we are guided by the Holy Spirit we can lose the track of meaningful living.

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost. We are reminded of the birthday of the Church. It was due to the descent and the power of the Holy Spirit that the disciples gained courage to proclaim the message of the Gospel of Christ. 'On Pentecost day the apostles had all met in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise which filled the whole house, ..... something like tongues of fire rested on each of them. They were filled with Holy Spirit...' (Act2:1-11). The Holy Spirit directs our thoughts, encourages us and gives us knowledge if we are open to His promptings. Saint Paul says, No one can say 'Jesus is the Lord' unless he is under the influence of the Holy Spirit' (1Cor12:3). Today's Gospel (Jn20:19-23) gives more understanding of the presence of the Holy Spirit within the Church,

when the Lord Jesus says 'Receive the Holy Spirit, for those whose sins you forgive they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain, they are retained'. May we, therefore, renew our reverence and devotion to sacramental commitment which we receive through the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit. We should always say, "Come Holy Spirit fill the hearts of thy faithful and enkindle in them thy fire of love..."
