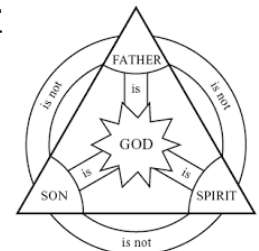

### 'THE MOST HOLY TRINITY.

Christian belief is rooted in the mystery of the most Holy Trinity, the mystery that God is One but three distinct Persons; the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit sharing the same Divine Nature, co-equal and co-eternal. Basing our thoughts and reflections on God's love for His creation and the mystery of human redemption, we can truly deepen our faith in the doctrine of the Most Holy Trinity. The Church teaches that 'The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the hierarchy of the truths of faith ...' (CCC 234). Our Lord Jesus promised his disciples a helper, who would not leave them, when he said, 'and I will ask the Father and he will give you another to be your Advocate, who will be with you for ever. This is the Spirit of truth whom the world cannot receive because it neither sees him nor knows him...' (Jn14:16-17). That was a collaborative action of the Divine Persons of the Most Holy Trinity. The disciples were also sent to baptise all nations who believed, in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. We are invited to develop our faith in the Most Holy Trinity day-by-day, through constant prayers and acts of piety.

Today, we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. We are invited to deepen our faith in God who has revealed himself to us as One God, but three Persons of the same Divine Nature, co-equal and co-eternal. In today's first reading from the book of Deuteronomy, Moses instructed the Israelites about the nature and power of God over all his creation. He called them to give him total respect and trust if they were to prosper and live. Moses said, "Understand this today, therefore, take it to heart: The Lord is God indeed, in heaven and above as on earth beneath, he and no other" (Deut4:39). Saint Paul's letter to the Romans also explains our union with the Most Holy Trinity. Saint Paul says, 'The Spirit himself and our spirit bear united witness that we are children of God' (Rm8:17). As we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity solemnity, may we deepen our faith in God. We should learn to work in unity at all levels of our human community. We should respect and love each other as members of humanity, saved by the Most Holy Trinity.
