"WHY ARE YOU SO FRIGHTENED?

As we travel in life we encounter different situations. These may include moments of joy or of sadness. We are normally advised to be prepared for any eventualities that occur during our life. Our bad or sad experiences may include; health breakdown, the death of a dear one, financial hardship, a crisis of faith, lack of employment or family relationship difficulties. These may come upon us like a storm and become a heavy burden which needs to be lifted from our shoulders by friends or family members who care. We get so anxious and worried when dealing with life during such moments. We should remember that it is often said, 'After the storm there is sunshine.' Above all, as Christians, we are called to trust in the Lord of life. Jesus said to his disciples, "Indeed, every hair of your head is counted. Do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows" (Lk12:7). The Lord cares for us so we need to have faith and trust in him in order to overcome the fears and worries of our lives

As we celebrate the 12th Sunday, the readings invite us not to be frightened but to trust in the Lord during the moments of difficulties in life. In the First reading, the Lord responds to Job's sincere and trustful prayer. Job did not give up his faith in the Lord, despite the difficulties he faced. He trusted in the Divine power to change his bad situation. This should be our response to the challenges of life. Similarly, in the Gospel, Jesus calmed the roaring sea that had brought a lot of fear and anxiety for the disciples. Sometimes we may feel that we are drowning under the waves of problems in our life. We need to hang on to the string of prayer for Jesus to lift us out. Our lack of faith and trust in the living presence of God can make us panic or even collapse and make more mistakes. Saint Paul in the Second reading. echoes the great love that God has for us. 'That through Christ's life, death, and resurrection we have been brought into new life with the Lord' (2Cor5:14-17). Therefore, together with the Psalmist, we can say 'O give thanks to the Lord, for his love endures for ever.' May we be constantly aware of the Lord's presence during our day-to-day earthly journey. So, let us not be frightened in life.
