## "YOU ARE PETER AND, ON THIS ROCK, I WILL BUILD MY CHURCH"

One of the major articles of our Christian faith points to the Apostles of the Lord. As we say, 'I believe in One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church....'. Saints Peter and Paul were chosen by the Lord Jesus to continue his mission of giving the message of salvation to humanity. This had been established through his life, teachings, death and resurrection. It was the complete revelation of the infinite love of God for humanity by Jesus Christ. The two saints were given unique roles on different occasions but each role was given in order to achieve the same mission of continuing with the message of salvation. Saint Peter, who was gifted with Holy Spirit-filled faith, was chosen as the leader of the twelve apostles of the Lord. Jesus said, 'Simon, son of Jonah, you are a happy man! Because it was not flesh and blood that revealed this to you but my Father in heaven' (Matt 16:17). Saint Paul was chosen during his conversion and he became a powerful instrument of God's word to the Gentiles or non-Jews. Saint Peter remained very instrumental in spreading the Good News of the Gospel among the Jewish communities. Their faith and commitment helped the early Church to grow as guided by the Holy Spirit. As leaders of the early, or infant, Church they faced a lot of challenges, rejection and opposition which resulted in their martyrdom under emperor Nero between 64 AD and 67AD in Rome and were buried there. This is the reason why the seat of the Vicar of Christ, the Pope, is in Rome at St. Peter's Basilica and it is a sign of the continuity and unity of the Church of Christ. As Christians, we are guided by memory, tradition and faith. Today, as we remember these great saints of our faith, may we learn from their example of dedication and service.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, the Scripture readings remind us of the role of leadership which is required for the unity and continuity Gospel of Christ. We are reminded to have loyalty and dedication to our faith and this calls for determination and courage. In what was a very difficult time for Saint Paul, after he had been imprisoned for witnessing to the truth of Christ's teaching, he said, 'I have fought the good fight to the end; I have run the race to the finish. I have kept the faith...' (2Tim4:6-7). Tradition holds that Saint Peter asked his executioners to crucify him upside-

down unlike the manner in which his Lord and Master, Jesus Christ, had been crucified. It was a sign of faith and humility. As Christians, let us not compromise our faith for worldly gains. On this occasion let us renew our faith and trust in the leadership of the Church as a gift given to us by the Lord. We should be positive towards our Church leaders and recognise them as human beings who may make mistakes. Saint Peter and Saint Paul faced challenges as human beings. Our Church leaders today may not be completely perfect, but we should pray for them to be guided by the grace of God. We should avoid derogatory comments regarding our Church leaders as they are chosen instruments of the Lord. May Saints Peter and Paul pray for us. Fr. Pontius Bandua CD
