THE SPIRITUAL BLINDNESS:

The Psalmist rightly says, "Your Word is a lamp for my feet" (119:105). In darkness, we stumble and fall. Light, therefore, is central to our human and spiritual wellbeing. The word of God guides us along our path in life. If we ignore His light, we live in the darkness of hatred, violence, grudge bearing and resentment. When we are guided by the truth and wisdom of the Lord's word we shall experience peace, love, mercy, understanding, tolerance, justice and fairness. In our modern time, many issues make us blind to knowing and following the truth. For example, many issues that have previously been upheld as conventional values are being questioned and downplayed. We think that we have the authority to change these values accordingly to suit our circumstances. In the most recent development of the world, a lot of changes have taken place in our spiritual, moral and socio-economic environment. These changes have either caused blind spots or have been downplayed in accordance with the perennial values of humanity. We, therefore, need the Word of God to guide our feet along the path in life's journey.

As we celebrate the 30th Sunday, the readings remind us of our spiritual blindness. Our sinful situation hinders us and we are unable to clearly see the will, love and mercy of God. It will not be until we turn to Christ for guidance and help that our eyes can be opened to enable us to see clearly. Just as in today's Gospel, the blind man, Bartimaeus shouted for help to Jesus, though people tried to stop him. "Son of David, Jesus, have pity on me" (Mk10:47). The blind man needed help to be healed and he had faith in Jesus. We have been reminded to have faith in Jesus and search for him, asking for help, just as the blind man did. Today, we can meet the Lord in the sacraments. It will be possible if we truly seek and ask for his help in faith. We can be made to be unsighted by our unmoderated emotions, passions, anger, hateful feelings, unforgiveness, pride, envy, jealousy and squabbles. In such situations,

we need to call on the name of Jesus, in faith, to heal our blindness of faith. The prophet Jeremiah gives hope to the remnant of Israel. "I will bring them back the blind, and lame, women with child, women in labour: a great company returning here... (Jer31:8-9). In this way, we also need to return to the Lord in order to have peace in our minds and hearts. We can endeavour to do so by removing all the blind spots in our spiritual life.
