PREPARE THE WAY OF THE LORD!

Planning and programming are essential aspects to any serious human endeavours. It is within such frameworks that the risks and benefits of any course of action can be identified. Unless we properly plan our life's activities, we can easily encounter difficulties and challenges which can cause us to abandon the given project. The need for planning cuts across all areas of our life including within our families, faith communities and economic or political organisations. Most importantly, however, our spiritual planning or readiness is the only way for us to resist temptation and sin. Advent is a season of waiting in holiness to meet the Holy One. We can, therefore, raise in-depth spiritual questions. How should we be prepared to meet the Lord at his second coming? Do our actions, thoughts and inclinations make us draw closer to the Lord with confidence? If we do not meet the standards of holiness, what should we do about it? The need for repentance and reconciliation with Lord and with each other is central for our preparation to meet the Lord. Today, if we still have tendencies of prejudice, pride, resentment, greed, addictions, an uncontrolled desire for material things and a lack of generosity, it is high time we delve into our inner lives and reform in readiness for the coming Christmas.

As we celebrate the 2nd Sunday of Advent, the readings invite us to prepare the way for the Lord's coming. Just as in the first reading, the prophet Baruch gave a consoling message to the Israelites who were discouraged and in exile. He said, 'For they went forth from you on foot, led away by their enemies; but God will bring them back to you ...For God has ordered that every high mountain, and everlasting hills be made low and the valleys filled up to make level ground...' (Bar5:7). The Israelites were exiled and ruled by foreigners because of their infidelity to the Lord's commandments. This affected the moral, social and spiritual fabric of their lives. They needed to reform their lives to get back to Jerusalem. As Christians today, we need to reform our lives in accordance with Lord of life by denouncing the modern ideologies of secularism, materialism and lukewarm attitudes which over turn the sanctity of human life. This similar message of preparation is echoed in the Gospel. John preached repentance to the people of Israel by quoting the prophet Isaiah 'Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight and rough places become level' (Lk3:4-6). As John preached repentance, he was preparing the ground for the Lord's coming. On the same note, we need to

level the mountains of pride and valleys of envy and hatred in our hearts and minds in order to welcome Lord. In the second reading, Saint Paul tells the Philippians to live in righteousness. He says, '...and so, be pure and blameless for the day of Christ...'. (Phil1:10-11). May we, therefore, humble ourselves as we prepare for the Lord's coming.
