

## **EPIPHANY OF THE LORD**

During the journey of life, there are many things that we focus upon. The most important of these is our eternal destiny with God. Just as we have begun the new year of 2025, our focus should be on how we can do better spiritually in this year of jubilee. We should always ponder on what the spiritual hurdles are in our lives by reflecting on the events of everyday life. It was within such a spiritual context that the wise men, or magi, interpreted the events of the time at the birth of Jesus. They made a prompt journey to search for the child king who had been born in Judea. As Christians, our intensive search in life should be to find meaning in Jesus, who was born among us to teach us the way of life. He is the light of the world and the lamp for our steps in life. May he be a light for our way in this year as it unfolds with joys and challenges. Epiphany means the manifestation of the glory of God in the world. We are, therefore, like the magi being called upon to focus on the star of life through the Holy Scriptures, the Holy Doctrines of the Church and the sacraments to renew our commitment to centre our lives on Christ.

As we celebrate the Epiphany, the readings draw our attention to focus on Christ as the light for our life's journey and for the world. He is king, born to establish God's kingdom on earth. The psalmist says, "All the nations on earth shall fall prostrate before you, O Lord." The universal mission of Christ is to reconcile the whole of creation to God. As Christians we should model our lives according to the universal love of God for all his people. There should be no disunity, partiality, favouritism, bias nor pride among his followers if we are to be the authentic Christians of these modern times. Saint Paul reiterates this by saying, "This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel" (Eph3:6). The gospel of Christ born for us, is of peace, reconciliation, faithfulness, piety, love, generosity and self-sacrificing. The question we can raise is, do we truly follow the gospel of Christ born to us and as searched by the magi? Or we are always inclined to worldly claims of human freedom and rights regardless of God's eternal plan for the universe. The wise men asked, "Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him" (Matt2:2). Prompted by their desire and the Spirit, they longed to see this king born to transform the world. We are told they brought him oiffs of

gold, frankincense and myrrh, the symbols of royalty. As the followers of Christ today, how can we follow His star everyday in our busy schedules? Secondly, as our universal king of life, what gifts can we offer him daily? Are we not likely to give excuses for our lack of commitment? Do we have a self-sacrificing attitude to help our families and parish community? May the Epiphany of the Lord transform our attitudes this year of jubilee.


